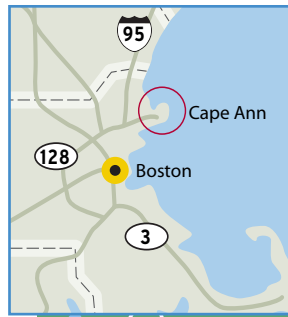

The Colonial Inn is located in the midst of the cultural activities and attractions of picturesque East Gloucester. Stroll to **Niles Beach** or take a short drive to **Good Harbor Beach**. Several excellent restaurants are also in walking distance from the inn.



The **Gloucester Stage Company** is within walking distance. Plays developed at the GSC have gone on to critical and popular acclaim on- and off-Broadway, across the United States, and around the world.



The nearby **North Shore Art Association** provides the largest collection of paintings and sculpture on Cape Ann with over 400 pieces of art on display. Other NSAA activities include classes, demonstrations, workshops, lectures, critiques, art auctions and musical presentations.



A short walk from the inn is **The Rocky Neck Art Colony**, America's oldest working art colony. Fitz Hugh Lane painted here in the 1840s and a steady stream of artists including Winslow Homer, Edward Hopper, Emile Gruppe and Maurice Prendergast, began migrating to Cape Ann to paint. The area remains home to a wide variety of working artists: painters, sculptors, photographers, jewelry makers and more with galleries and studios in Rocky Neck.



Beauport, the summer home of the collector and interior designer Henry Davis Sleeper, is a fantasy house built on the rocks overlooking Gloucester Harbor about one mile from the Inn. Crowned

by towers, dormers, and dovescotes, the structure encloses a labyrinth of rooms decorated to evoke different historical and literary themes.

Another popular attraction is the **Eastern Point Lighthouse**, located at the end of Eastern Point. The parking lot is open year round with access to the stone breakwater that provides beautiful views of the lighthouse and the surrounding area.
